Please read this information before completing this form

About this form

This form is used to apply for voluntary deregistration of a co-operative under the *Co-operatives Act 2009* (the Act) provided it meets certain criteria.

Once deregistered, the co-operative ceases to exist as a legal entity and can no longer do anything in its own right.

How to complete this form

- You can complete this form onscreen and print it out or print and complete it by hand.
- If completing by hand use a blue or black pen and print using BLOCK letters.
- Complete all sections of the application and the contact details in all cases.
- Attachments are required as part of this application. Refer to the document checklist in section 4.

Fees

Please refer to our [Co-operatives fees and forms webpage](#) for the current fees. Fees are exempt from GST and subject to change without notice.

If you lodge this form by post or email, you will be emailed a Payment Number (PN) to make payment by credit card or Bpay via Consumer Protection's secure online payment portal.

Guides and related information

The process for voluntary deregistration is the same as for a company under section 601AA of the *Corporations Act 2001*.

To apply co-operatives, need to ensure that they meet the following requirements:

- all members have agreed to its deregistration.
- the co-operative is not conducting business.
- the co-operative's assets are worth less than \$1,000.
- the co-operative has paid all fees and penalties payable under the Act.
- the co-operative has no outstanding liabilities (e.g. unpaid employee entitlements or taxation liabilities).
- the co-operative is not involved in any legal proceedings.

Applications that do not meet these requirements (including lodgement of due annual returns) and are not signed by the co-operatives director or secretary will be rejected.

Co-operatives should also consider doing the following prior to submitting this form:

- check that any bank accounts in the co-operative's name are closed, regardless of the balance.
- review the co-operative's records/registers to ensure all property is dealt with (e.g. vehicles, land, shares, leases, permits)
- ensure all transfers of co-operative's property are registered and no property is held in the co-operatives name.
- ensure all registered business names held by the co-operative are cancelled or transferred.
- ensure any licenses held by the co-operative are cancelled or ceased.

What happens next

- The form and supporting documents will be reviewed. The contact person will be notified in writing if further information is needed.
- If approved, the contact person will be informed of the co-operatives impending deregistration with notice of the proposed deregistration published in the WA Government Gazette. The contact will also be given notice when the Co-operative has been deregistered.
- Otherwise, if refused, we will provide notification of the reasons why.
- If any change in the information you have provided in your application occurs, you must notify the Department as soon as possible.
