## **National Licensing Taskforce information sessions rescheduled**

Consumer Protection would like to advise real estate agents and sales representatives that the Commonwealth National Licensing Taskforce (Taskforce) briefing session for Property Occupations has been <u>rescheduled</u>.

The Taskforce briefing session will be held on 25 September 2012 at the Mercure Perth between 9.30am and 12.30pm. People who have already registered for the briefing have been contacted by the Commonwealth to advise them of the changed schedule. The briefing was previously scheduled to be held on 25 September 2012 between 1.00pm and 4.30pm.

The Taskforce recently released the Commonwealth Consultation Regulation Impact Statement (RIS) for Property Occupations. The RIS describes how the Taskforce will introduce national licences for some professions, including property occupations.

The Taskforce briefing sessions will outline the proposed reforms.
